Los Gatos Art Association Annual Open Juried Show – 2008 April 3 - May 2, 2008

Guest Juror: George Rivera, Executive Director and Senior Curator, Triton Museum of Art, Santa Clara determines selection for inclusion by review of delivered original artwork -- not by slides, prints or digital files.

ELIGIBILITY

- Limit two artworks per artist.
- Adult (18 years or older).
- All work must be original in concept and executed within the last 3 years by the artist.

INELIGIBLE ARTWORKS

- Work previously shown at Art Museum of Los Gatos.
- Renditions based on copyright protected sources used without permission of copyright holder.
- Work done under instructor.
- Wearable art or jewelry, functional ceramic, crafts, installations or video/films.

AWARDS

- First, Second and Third Place awarded in categories with 15 or more entries.
- First and Second Place awarded in categories with 10 to 14 entries.
- First Place awarded in categories with 5 to 9 entries.
- Categories with 4 or less entries may be combined with another category.

LABELS -- Use LGAA label

- Artwork distinctly titled. No 'untitled' accepted.
- Fill in and copy LGAA label from entry form.
- Fill in LGAA label completely with artist's name, artwork's title, primary media, category, phone number, and retail value. (See Sales Tax & Commission)
- Attach LGAA label on upper back of 2D art, or on the bottom of 3D art.

PRESENTATION:

- Wall art adequately framed, wired, and ready for hanging. Wire in good condition.
- Mats neatly cut and clean. Neutral or off-white preferred but not required.
- Canvas edges clean or painted with no visible staples.
- Plexiglas glazing preferred. Artist is responsible for any damage resulting from glass glazing material.
- No protruding eyehooks or sawtooth hangers.
- No framing with pressure-spring clips used for attaching the hanging wire.
- LGAA label attached and filled out.
- Entry forms completed and signed.

SIZE

- 2D Maximum shall not exceed 50" in either direction (including frame).
- 2D Minimum image size (excluding frame) 8" x 10" or 80 square inches.
- 3D art shall be stand-alone, and not exceed 3' x 5' x 8' (120 cubic feet) or 75 pounds.
- Unconnected 2D pieces not accepted as single entry.
- Unconnected 3D artworks to be considered as a single entry should have a base in common provided by the artist and the total of all parts remain within the size and weight limits.

ENTRY FEES (non-refundable)

- You may become a member when you enter.
- Incomplete or unsigned entry forms, or returned checks may disqualify entry.
- Make checks payable to Los Gatos Art Association.

Deadline for Mailed Early Entry Forms:

Postmarked by Friday, March 21, 2008.

No changes or modifications to pre-registered Early Entries after March 21, 2008.

Early Entry Fees:

\$15 per artwork for LGAA members.
\$18 per artwork for non-members.

Art Intake Day, Sunday, March 30, 2008.

At-The-Door Fees apply when completed entry form is delivered with artwork.
\$20 per artwork for LGAA members.
\$25 per artwork for non-members.

SALES TAX and COMMISSION

All artwork must be for sale.
Art Museum of Los Gatos handles sales and retains a 30% commission plus 8.25% sales tax.

To calculate retail value, multiply artwork's base price by 1.55 (Artwork x 1.55 = Retail Price/Value). The result will include the 30% commission and sales tax. Round up to the nearest \$1 or \$5 amount.

The retail price printed in the program will be the retail price shown on the entry/label as calculated and written by the artist.

DELIVERY/ART INTAKE DAY

Sunday, March 30, Noon to 4:00 p.m.

Hand deliver artwork to Art Museum of Los Gatos located at Lait Avenue and W. Main St. Los Gatos. Museum does not accept shipments.

PARKING is limited. Drop-off area for artworks and handicapped parking at museum is available.

ARTWORK PICK-UP AND RECEIPTS

- Exhibited artwork, sold or not, may not be removed until close of show. No exceptions.
- All artwork is signed in and signed out.
- On Art Intake Day, artist receives a receipt for all submitted artwork.
- Please present receipt when picking up any artwork.
- If someone other than artist picks up artwork, please present written authorization along with LGAA receipt.
- Museum unable to store unsold or unaccepted artworks.
- Plan ahead. At end of show any artwork not retrieved by **Saturday, May 3, 4:00 pm** is subject to a late fee of \$3 per day for each piece of art, payable to Art Museum of Los Gatos -- *between shows the museum is closed for several days.*
- Art not picked up within 30 days becomes the property of Art Museum of Los Gatos and may be used in future fund-raising events.
