#### SELECTION JUROR

##### Claire Schroeven Verbiest

Claire is an award-winning artist and a signature member of several art societies. Verbiest is considered one of the finest watercolor and pastel artists in the San Francisco Bay Area.

She is well known for her lively, crisp and truthful depictions of people, landscapes, flowers and objects and for her distinctive use of color.

She conducts watercolor and pastel painting workshops and frequently serves as a juror for local and international art shows.

In May and June 2007, 29 of her pastel paintings were on display in a solo exhibition at the Triton Museum of Art in Santa Clara, California.

#### AWARDS JUROR

##### Preston Metcalf

Preston is presently the Art Curator at the Triton Museum of Art in Santa Clara. He began his career as Curator of Art at the San Jose Museum of Art, moved to the Triton as Curator of Education and then as its Assistant Director. He left the Triton for the Executive Directorship of the San Jose Institute of Contemporary Art before returning to his current position.

Preston also teaches Art History at the Triton, Mission College, and San Jose City College. He has lectured throughout this country, as well as abroad, and has had more than sixty articles and essays on artists and art history published.

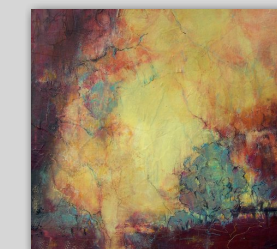
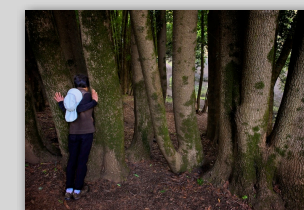
